

Frequently Asked Questions about the ACCT Philly Fix Philly Felines initiative:

Can I bring my pet cat?

No, this initiative is focused on community cats (unowned outside cats) only. However, if you need help having your cat spayed/neutered, please check out local low cost clinics here, or contact our Help Desk at helpdesk@acctphilly.org

What if I make an appointment but aren't able to trap the cat I was hoping to bring in?

Trap happens! Please just let us know as soon as you can that you will not be bringing the cat in, so that we can release your appointment to someone else.

Is this a permanent program?

No, this is an initiative made possible by a generous donor, but unfortunately we do not receive enough funding to provide the services we are contracted to do, so cannot expand to other programs unless the City decides to provide us with the funding necessary to operate for the next fiscal year.

How do you know these cats being trapped aren't owned?

We don't. That's why it's all the more important that after you get the cat back, you release them back where they were found. With that said, we

What if the cat I bring ends up sick or has an injury?

This initiative is limited to providing spay/neuter, vaccines and flea/tick preventative. If a cat is ill or injured, we will let you know as soon as we find out, and try to help with the best next steps.
