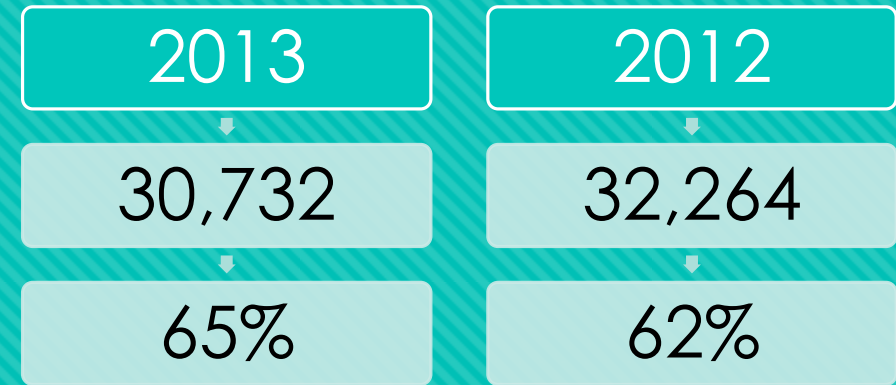

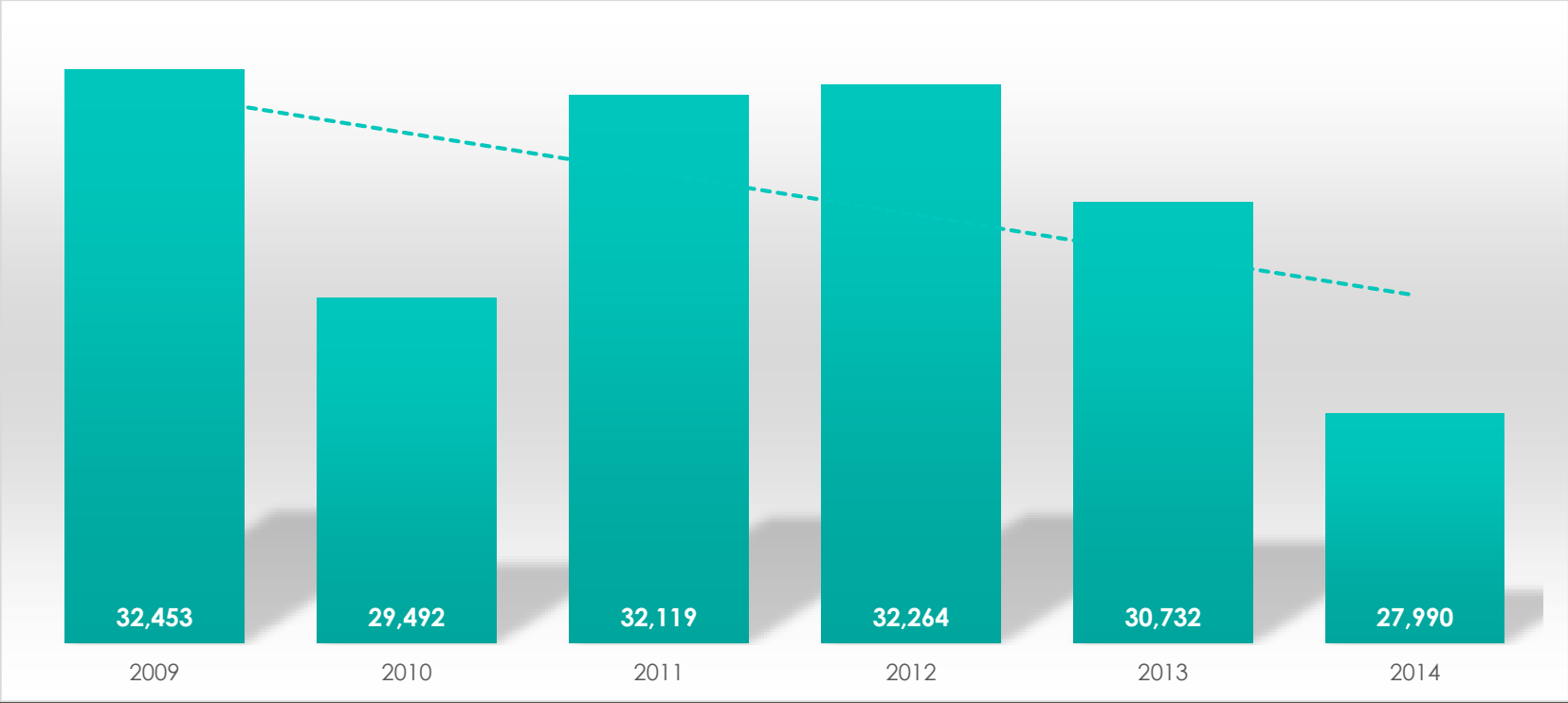

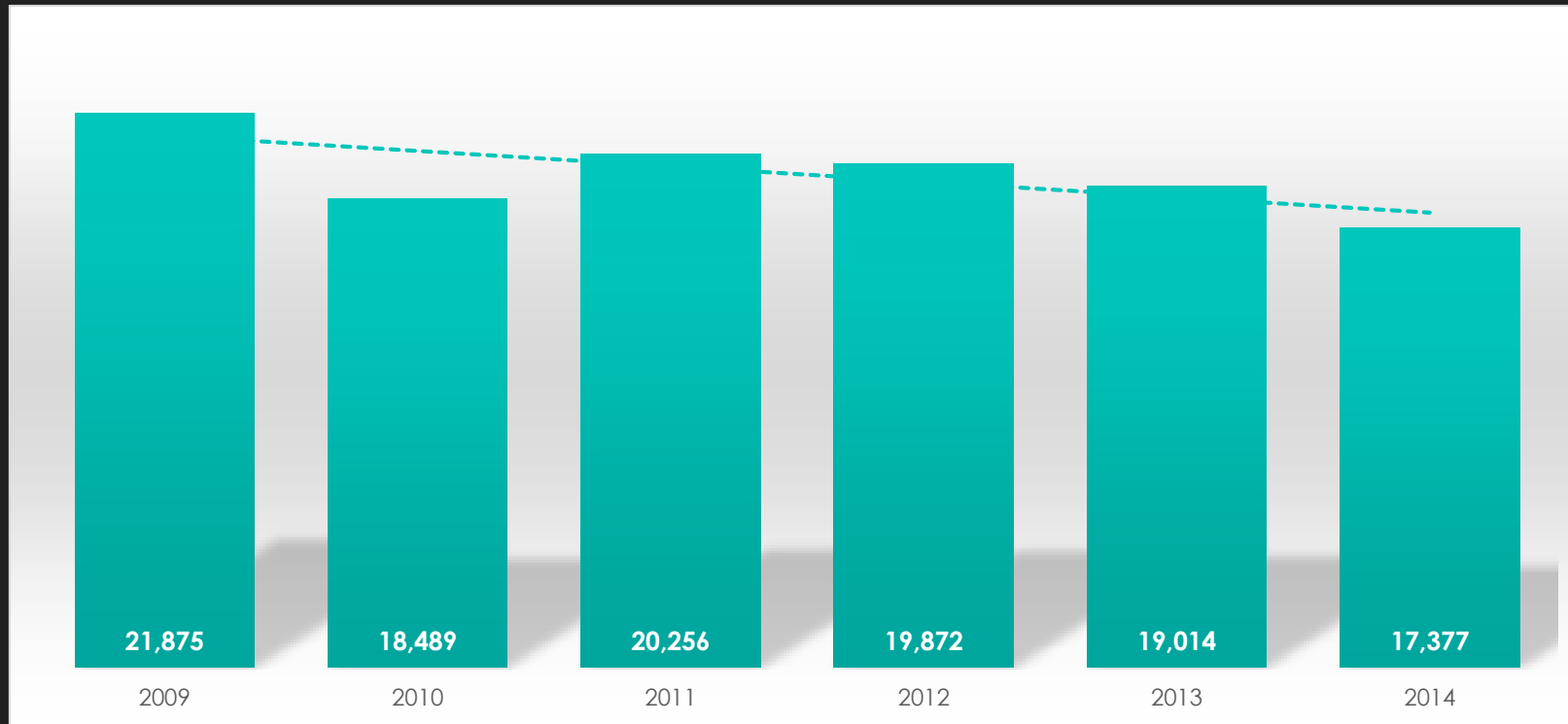


Incoming animals – live release rate

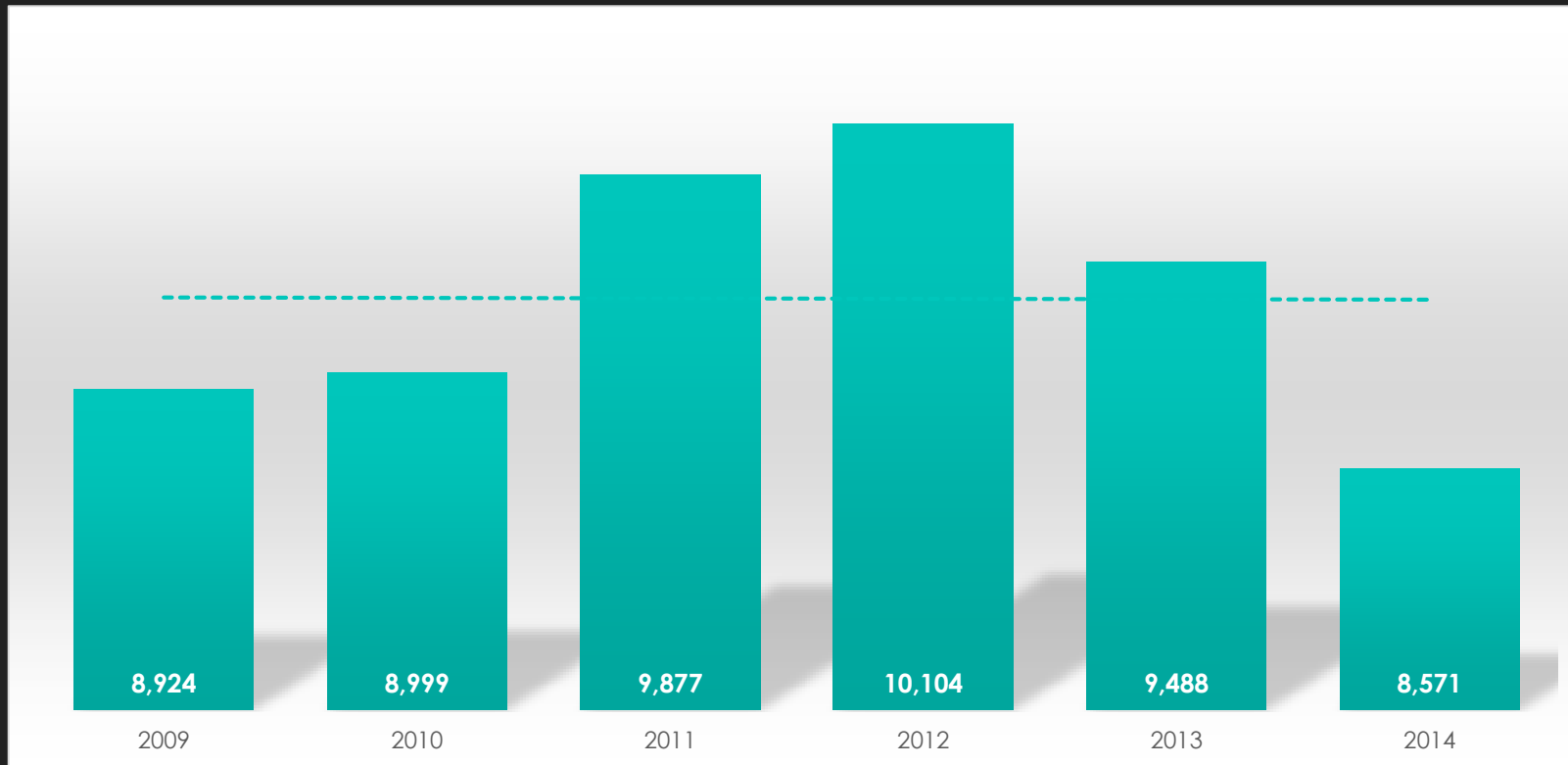

Intakes, cats

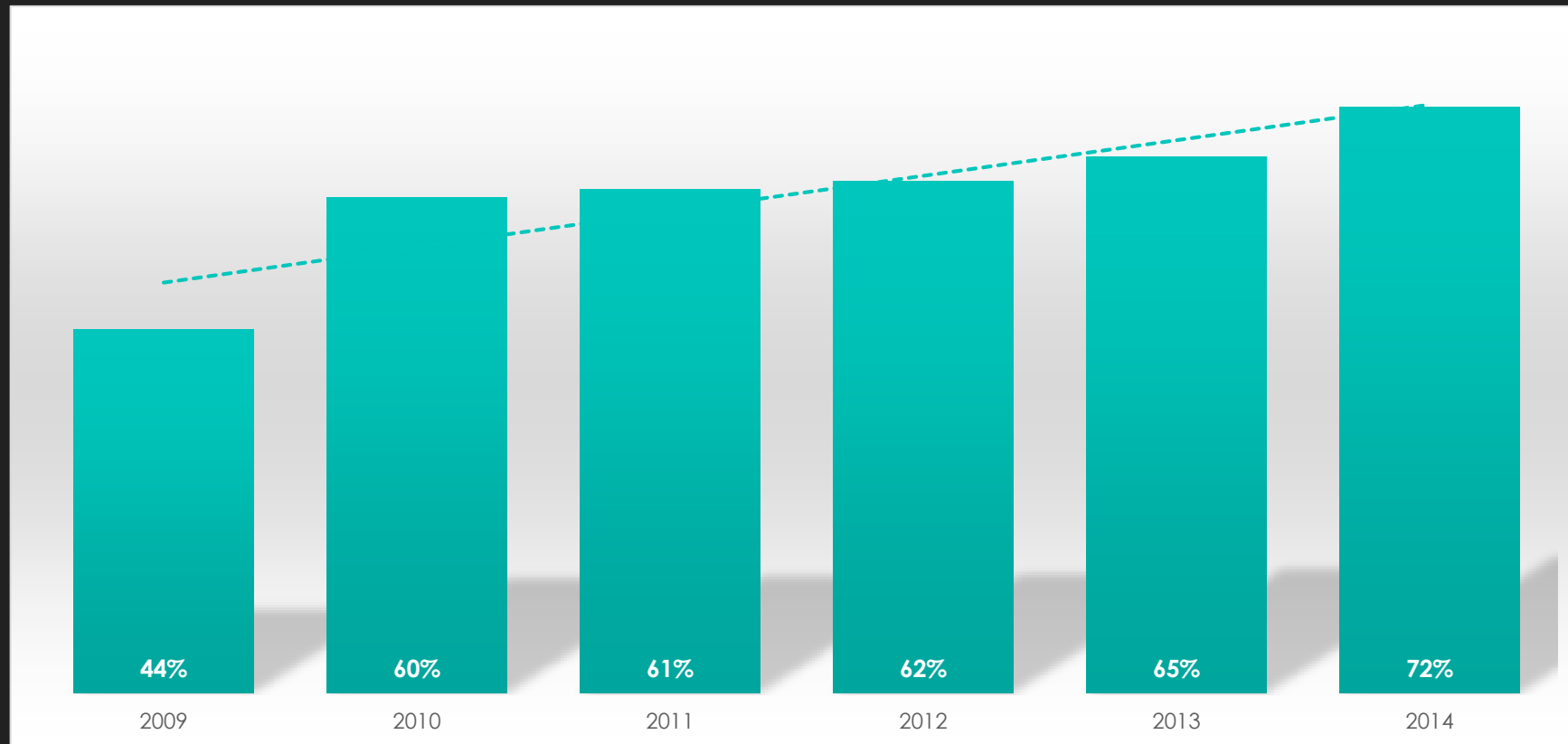


Intakes, dogs

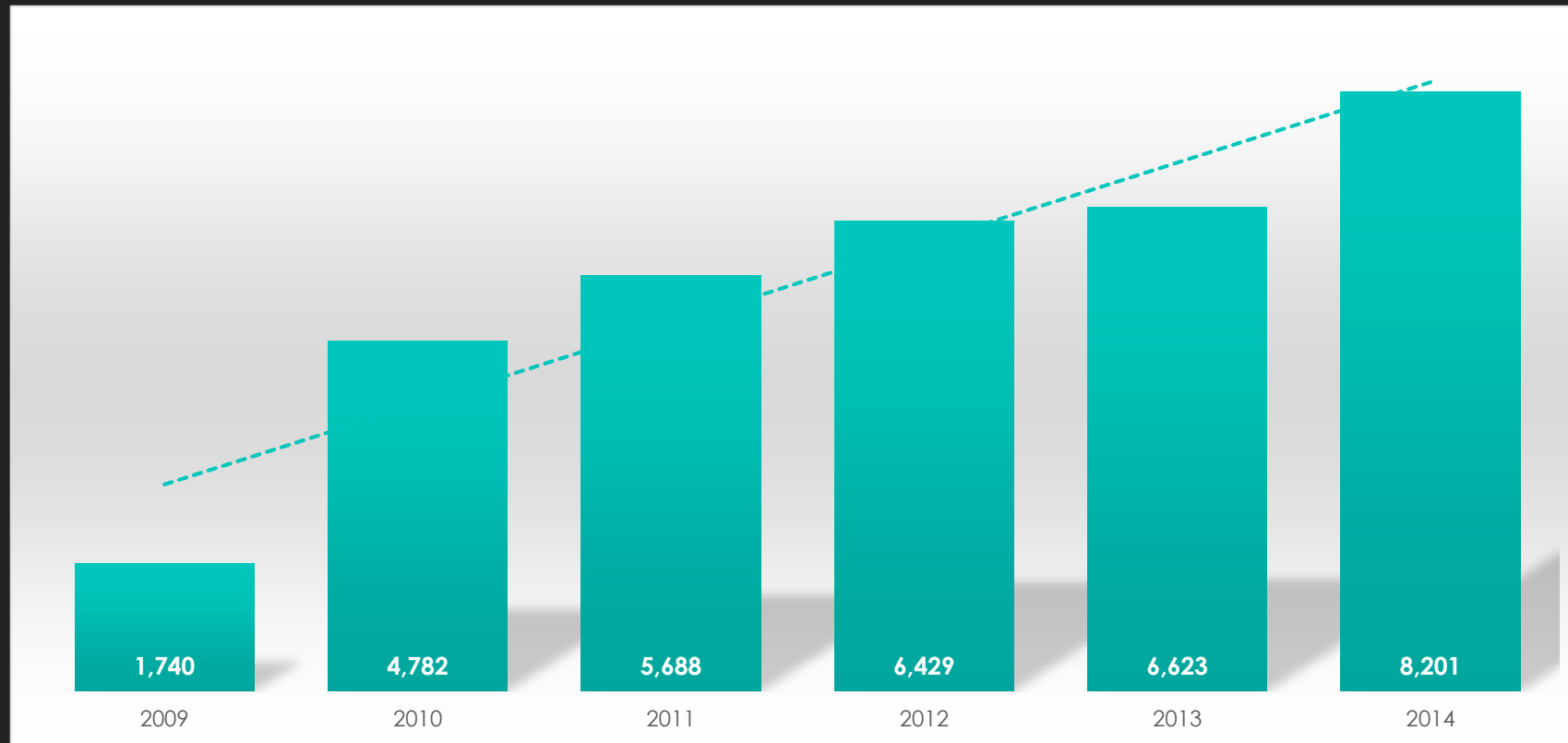
With 19,207 animals re-entering the community through ACCT Philly's lifesaving programs, more families acquire a new pet originating from ACCT Philly than any other local source.

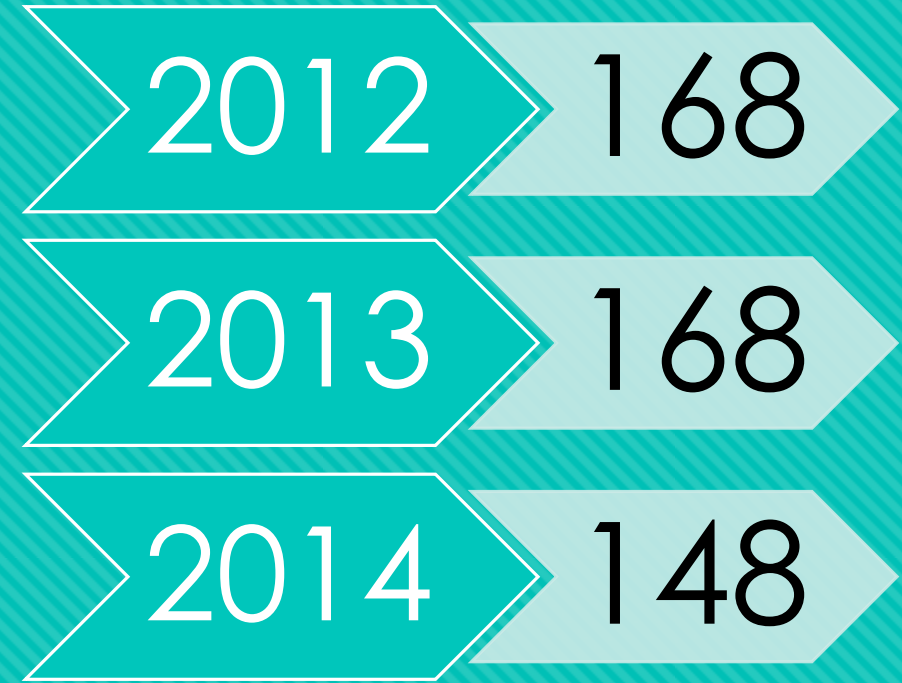

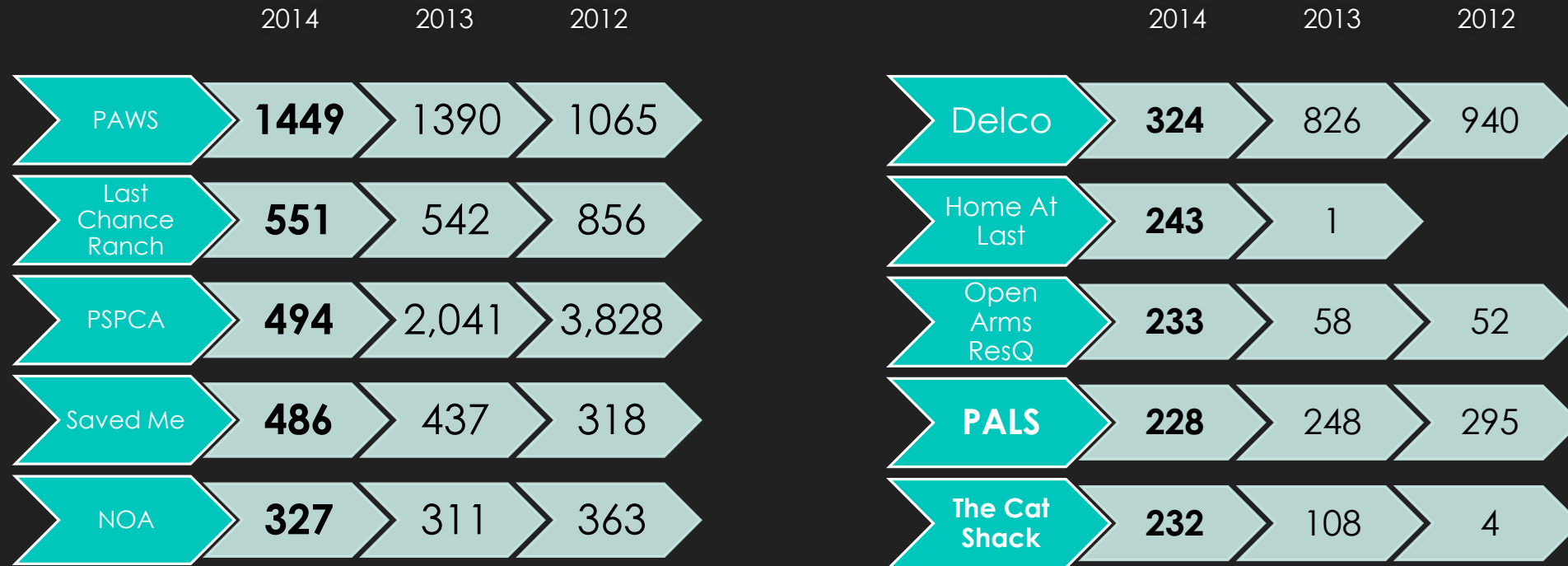

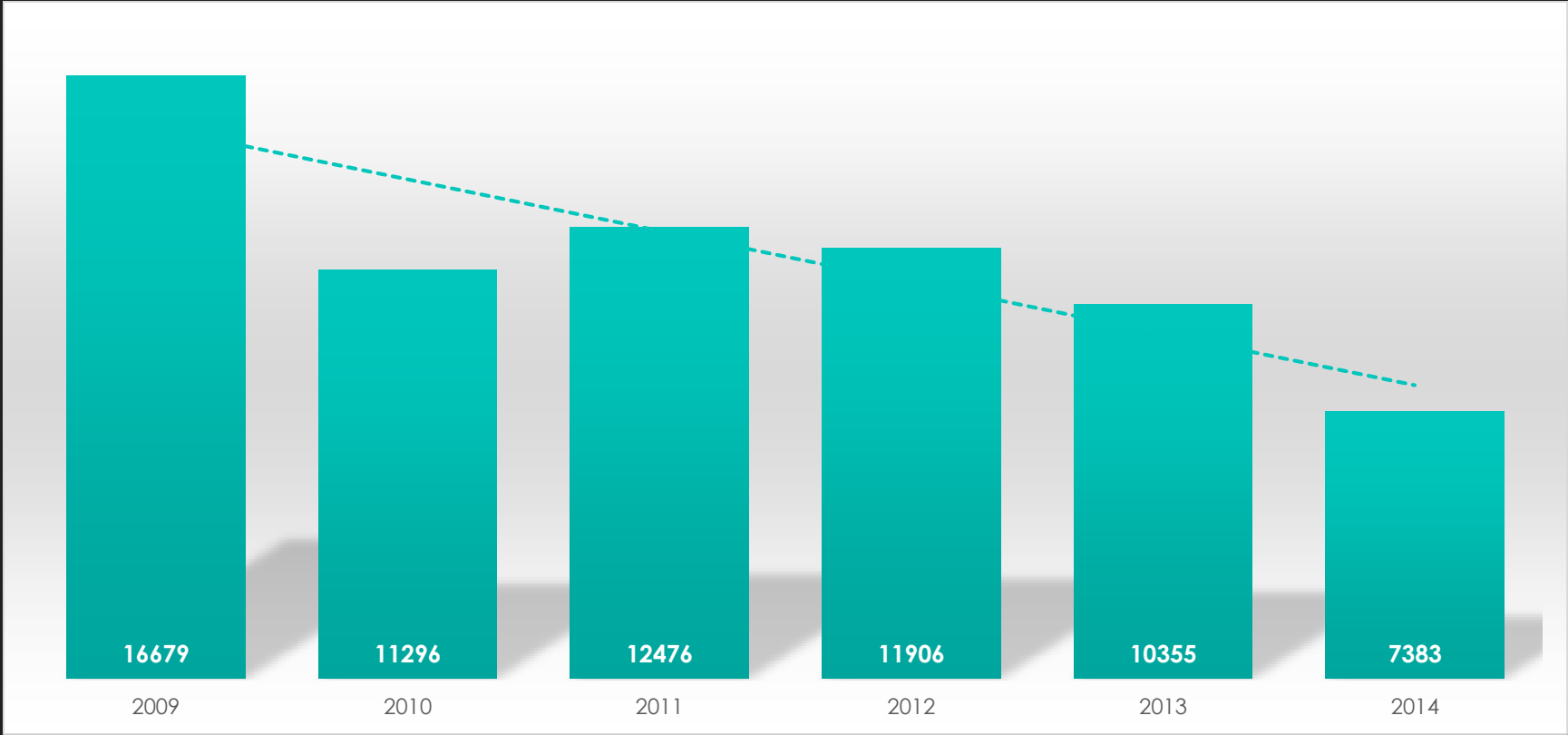
